

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS COUNTY OF MATHEWS

The Mathews County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing at 6:00 P.M. Tuesday March 28, 2023, at the Mathews County High School in the Harry M. Ward Auditorium on the following;

1. To obtain input from Mathews County taxpayers as to whether or not the County should spend approximately \$307,000 to repair the unsafe structure it owns located at 384 Old Ferry Road (Hole in The Wall Waterfront Grill).
2. A Resolution containing a budget amendment to address proposed expenditures exceeding 1% of the total operating budget for the County.

3. Revision and update of the Dangerous and Vicious Dog Ordinance to conform to state law. The proposed Ordinance would, in accordance with state law, increase the fee for an initial dangerous dog registration from \$50 to \$150; the subsequent annual registration cost would be \$85; the Ordinance would also require that the owner of a dangerous dog obtain liability insurance coverage in at least the amount of \$100,000 to cover animal bites or obtain and maintain a bond in surety to the value of at least \$100,000 in lieu of liability insurance. Citizens are encouraged to review the entire Ordinance as it is a complete rewrite of sections 6-2 through 6-10 of the Mathews County Code.
